

CHROME PLATED MAINTENANCE GUIDE

Allproof supplies a range of brass products that have been chrome plated, this finish may require regular maintenance to keep its aesthetic appearance.

Allproof would like to clarify that the chrome plated finish to a selection of our grates is for aesthetic purposes only, any damage to this layer does not effect the performance of the product in any way.

We recommend regular cleaning of these grates to avoid build up of bacteria in the form of small black marks. This can multiply over time causing pitting and deterioration of the chrome layer.

Cleaning:

- > Regularly remove and clean grates, this should be done when cleaning the surrounding facilities.
- > Remove any attached debris with a soft wet sponge to avoid scratching.
- > Wash down products with a soft brush and/or cloth using standard household detergent mixed in warm water.
- > Thoroughly rinse with fresh water to remove any remaining detergent.

Polishing:

- > A soft cloth/rag can be used to wipe/buff the surfaces clean in conjunction with a chrome polish. Follow directions of use from the chrome polish product supplier.

Do Not:

- > Use abrasive products such as steel wool, scrapers, scouring liquids or powders.

Allproof would like to advise that this finish is the same as other bathroom fittings (i.e. tapware) and encourage a similar approach to a cleaning schedule and process. Often bathrooms that receive irregular use will be subject to a higher increase of bacteria growth and may require more regular cleaning.
